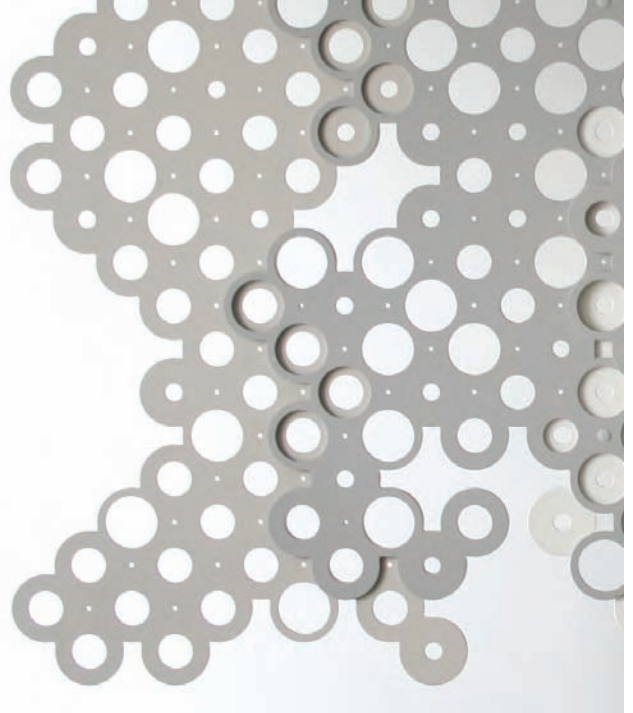
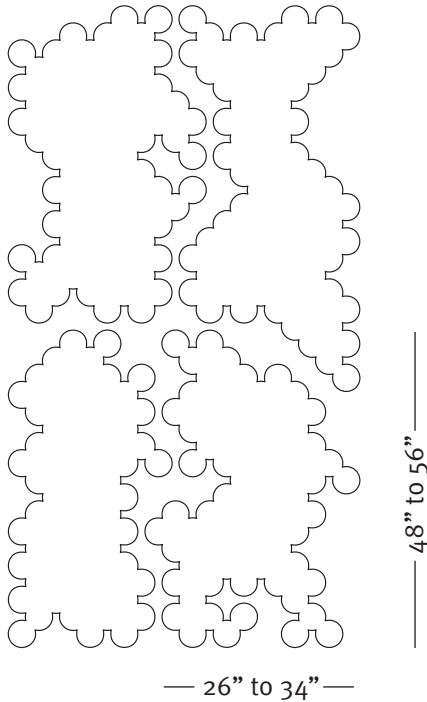

Modular Screen

Inspired in part by camouflage patterns, Modular Screen is a space-defining system of perforated panels comprised of a series of CNC milled layers, designed to de-emphasize the individual panel when the pieces are assembled together. Thin and lightweight, the Modular Screen can be configured in an unlimited number of layouts, allowing the user to control the resulting levels of opacity and transparency. The result is a flexible hanging partition in which the layering of individual pieces in fact conceals its modular nature.

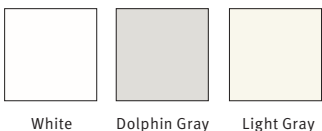
About Moorhead & Moorhead

Moorhead & Moorhead is a New York-based architecture and industrial design studio, formed in 2000 by brothers Granger and Robert Moorhead. Driven by the inventive aspects of design, their work explores issues of function and materiality at a range of scales. The M&M studio includes a prototyping shop that allows them to push materials to their limits.

Dimensions: Each panel is approximately 26" to 34" wide (between 66 cm and 86.4 cm) by 48" to 56" long (between 121.9 cm and 142.2 cm) by 1/4" thick (0.6 cm).

Materials: CNC-milled high-density polyethylene.

Colors: Standard colors (as shown above) are White / White, Dolphin Gray and Light Gray. Set includes four panels - one of each pattern shown above. One panel of each standard color is included in a set - the 4th panel is a randomly selected repeating color.
